TUNIS, Dec. 17 (Xinhua) -- A solar photovoltaic power station built by Chinese companies was inaugurated on Tuesday in central Tunisia's Kairouan province.

Located in the Kairouan governorate of northeastern Tunisia, the project is expected to generate approximately 222 GWh of electricity annually, enough to power around 43,000 homes.

UAE-based renewables developer AMEA Power has commissioned a 120MW solar PV plant in the central Tunisian governorate of Kairouan, the country's largest operational PV project.

The power station is a ground-mounted solar project sitting on 200 hectares (490 acres). It comprises 220,416 modules, each with capacity of 545W, capable of generating 120 megawatts at ...

To bolster its solar energy capacity, the Tunisian government signed agreements with renewable energy firms Scatec and Aelous to build solar plants in Sidi Bouzid and Tozeur.

The project--located in Kairouan province--is the largest photovoltaic power generation plant in the country,
