

Will energy storage products be subject to additional tariffs

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So while durable protectionist policies will likely push U.S. energy storage buyers to seek U.S.-assembled batteries, tariffs on key inputs mean those locally-produced alternatives will cost...

Two major areas of international trade that will remain causes of concern for energy storage projects are the application of tariffs and supply chain integrity.
